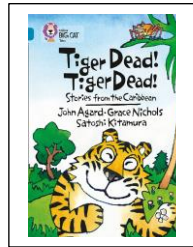


English

Ancient Egypt

Throughout Term 1 and 2 we will be learning all about Ancient Egypt. This term's focus will be on the hierarchy of Ancient Egypt, the role of the Pharaoh and the purpose of the impressive Pyramids. We will look at the discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb by Howard Carter in 1922, and how this aided our understanding of the lives of the Ancient Egyptians.



Maths

In our first term as Year 3s we will learn how to use TT Rockstars to better our rapid recall of our times tables.

We are also going to begin to use a range of methods to add and subtract mentally.

Lastly, we will look at the 2D faces on 3D shapes and attempt to make them as nets and models.



Cartouches Art and Design Technology

Across Art and DT we are going to be creating our own cartouche. After designing, we will practise using plasticine to practise and then a 'slip and blend' method will create a cartouche using clay.
