

Code of Conduct for Remote Learning

This code of conduct outlines what we expect of pupils and parents / carers during remote learning. Much of this echoes our expectations when in school and it is designed to keep you safe online and help you to get the best out of your learning.



- Myself and my parents / carers will check Seesaw and Parent Mail regularly to keep track of online lessons and notifications
- I will regularly check TT Rock Stars, **ReadiWriter** and MyMaths for tournaments and activities
- I will only use Seesaw and **Teams** as directed by my teacher and will only upload anything that is related to my learning
- I will only use my **Teams** account when my teacher tells me to do so
- I will not take screenshots / photographs of my screen or any live or pre-recorded learning
- I will always make sure that my communication on all learning platforms is supportive of my learning and the wellbeing of others
- I understand that my teacher is only available between the hours of 8.30am and 3.30pm



If I am taking part in live lessons, I will make sure that:



- my learning environment is quiet and I will not get distracted easily
- the background is appropriate (check what is behind you!)
- I am dressed appropriately
- I am listening and responding
- I speak to others politely and listen to others' points of view

Remember everything that is posted on social media is there forever – we have a digital footprint that can never be fully deleted. So be careful of what you say and write on all of our online learning platforms.
