## Trim Tail – Timetable

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### School Money

- KS2 Councillors were wanted to change the reward system in place for Super Stars for the upper school.

- One councillor suggested the use plastic coins as paper designs could be made or copied at home
- Chairman and the Vice Chairman are happy to run the ROX shop and bank on a Friday playtime.
- The shop/bank to be located in one half of the reading pod in the KS2 playground.
- Children can collect and exchange their Super Stars for Rox coins.

- Children suggested a variety of prizes they would like to win including a lucky dip for 1 Rox coin, a drone for 10 Rox coins, a digital camera for 20 Rox coins.
