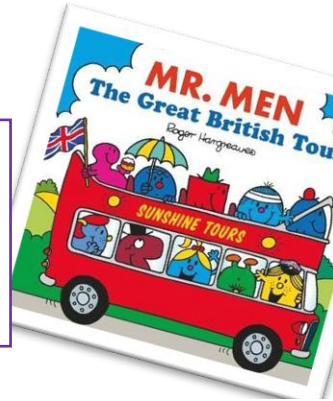


Wonderful WOW Words
