There are so many kinds of texts and they are used in different situations. The children will enjoy exploring instructions, diary entries and descriptive writing.

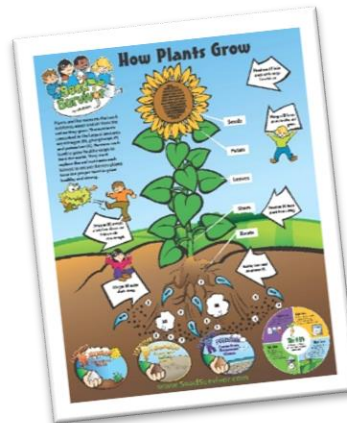
Dive into Dover
