

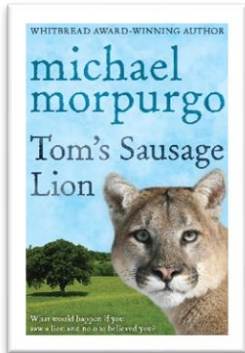
Writing

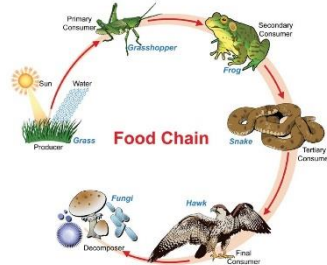
3, 2, 1 Blast Off!
