

Writing

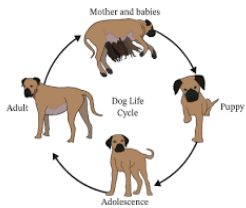

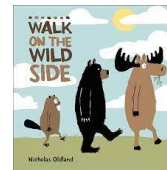
Maths

Year 2 will be continuing developing their strategies for addition, subtraction, which includes partitioning and solving two-step worded problems. We will be looking at time and how our knowledge of the 5 times tables can help us read an analogue clock.

Walking in the wild



This term the children will explore and learn about wildlife and the animals that live in wild habitats across the globe. We will be looking at different countries and how their wildlife differs from ours here in Dover. We will be looking at what animals need to live and how humans can help these wild animals' live long and healthy lives!



Science

The children will investigate the similarities and differences between humans and animals. This term we will be looking at nutrition and what are the basics needed for animals and humans to survive? We will also look at the importance of exercise and eating a healthy and balanced diet.

Year 2 will develop their running, jumping and throwing skills throughout the term and prepare themselves for the team games for sports week.
