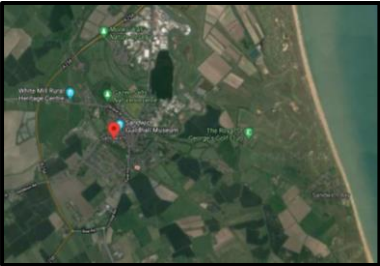


**English**

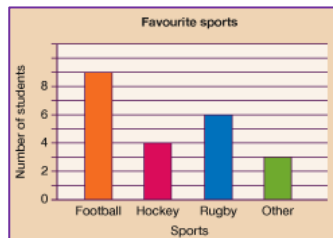
We will be exploring a wide variety of texts, from non-fiction instructional texts to the figurative language of poetry.
