

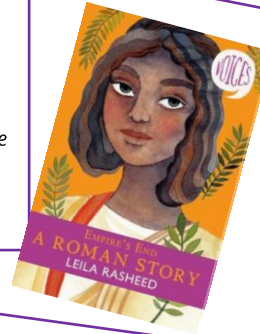


Mixed Media Artist

This term we will be focusing on the exceptional art produced by Teesha Moore. We will learn about her journey to become an artist and what inspired some of her most famous pieces. We will learn about the different mediums she uses in her artwork and attempt to design and create our own collage!



This term the children will be delving into the period of the Romans in Britain and considering how their lives have impacted ours today. We will begin our topic by looking at the city of Rome, comparing it to Britain. We will then learn about volcanoes – how they are formed and their impact to Italy and the people that live there.



Working as a Scientist

The children will be introduced to the measurement topic of length in Maths this term where we will be considering the size of a Roman shield. We will then be able to calculate how long the testudo (tortoise formation) could have been.
