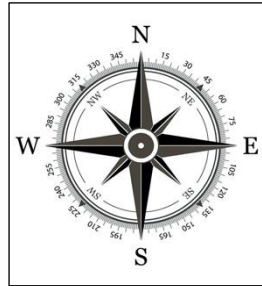


**Maths**
