

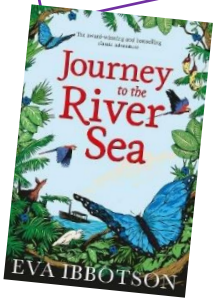


The Vikings

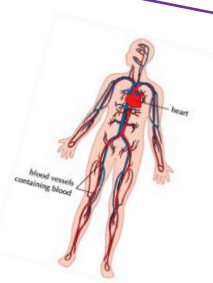
This term we will begin by learning about the journeys that other people have made to Britain. We will learn about why the Vikings decided to invade and their journey to England and then their conquering of Britain and the life they made for themselves here. We will be reflecting on the effects on this invasion on the people of Britain and how evidence of this remains today.

Circulatory System

This term, Year 6 will be learning about how blood journeys around our circulatory system. We will investigate what the function of our heart is and how the heart muscle functions. The children will also review the work of William Harvey and his discoveries surrounding the journey of blood around the circulatory system.



This term the children will explore journeys, we will be exploring journeys that people have made and the journeys that happen within ourselves in terms of our learning and understanding, but also journeys that are made every second of the day inside our bodies as we learn all about our circulatory system and the journey of our blood.
