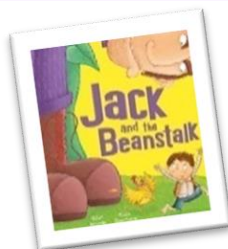


Topic Title: Ready, Steady, Grow

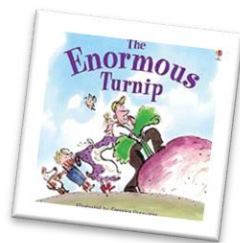


A Seed's Needs
